**GENERAL RULES FOR ALL DIVISIONS**  
**Please Read Carefully**

1. No entry fee will be charged for placing exhibits in the fair, HOWEVER, all youth entries must be an active member of 4-H, F.C.C.L.A., F.F.A. or any organized club and must sell one (1) Fair Membership. Adults must be a member of the Jim Wells County Fair Association. The Senior Citizens Division is open to any county resident 60 or over, for free.

2. All articles must be the completed work of the exhibitor and completed since the last fair in **October, 2010**. All articles must be undamaged and clean. Unfinished articles will not be accepted. The Superintendent of each department has the authority to reject unworthy exhibits or items not packaged according to **DIVISION RULES** or to reclassify any articles. (Any item in Clothing, Textiles or Crafts must be in separate disposable plastic bags.) Food items must be in Zip-Lock Bags, see Food Department rules for specific instructions.

**FOOD REQUIRING REFRIGERATION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**  
**RECIPES MUST BE TYPED - READY TO PRINT.**

3. Any article which has been entered and judged previously in the Jim Wells County Fair cannot be exhibited or judged again.
4. Participants may enter as many entries in any given Division, but only one (1) per class; Example: Division Cake: Class: Angel Food.
5. **All articles must be Pre-Registered to be eligible for judging. All entry forms must be completed in detail and returned for each item to be entered. Entry forms will be available from the Extension Agent's Office and must be returned by September 9, 2011 by 4:30 p.m. to the same office. A sample form is enclosed. No late entries will be accepted.**
6. **All entries in the Home Economics Division are to be entered with the Department Superintendent on Monday, October 17, 2011 between 3:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. No late entry forms will be accepted after September 9, 2011.** Judging will be done on Tuesday, October 18, 2011 beginning at 9:00 a.m.
7. Entries will be judged and given ribbons according to scores received. Ribbons are awarded on the basis of: Blue 100-90; Red 89-80; White 79-70. Any score below 70 is rejected. There will be Class Ribbons awarded in each Class when there are three (3) or more items. A Blue Ribbon or Class Champion Ribbon is required for Division Champion. **NO DIVISION CHAMPION RIBBONS WILL BE AWARDED TO PRE-4-H GROUP.**
8. Only those entries receiving ribbons will remain on display until October 22, 2011. **A portion of the cakes and pies will be displayed and the remaining must be redeemed from the Department Superintendent between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. on October 18, 2011.** Other items which may be removed on October 18, 2011 are entries which did not receive ribbons and/or rejected items.
9. In each division, a class will be established when there are at least three (3) similar Pre-Registered entries. Example: If three (3) jars of pickled peppers are entered, they will be judged as a class and not as a miscellaneous item.

10. A Sweepstake Rosette and Plaque will be awarded to the individual with the greatest number of points in each of the Pre-4-H, Sub-Youth, Youth, Young Adult, Adult and Senior Citizen Age Groups. Points will be tabulated from their Class Ribbons and Division Champions. Class ribbons will count for 5 points and Division Champions will count 10 points. In case of a tie, the individual with the most total ribbons will be the winner. All age division runner-ups will receive the Reserve Plaque and Champion Ribbon. The Sweepstakes Awards will be presented at the Queen's Contest on Wednesday, October 19, 2011. **Grand Champion Sweepstakes award may only be awarded to the same individual 2 consecutive years in any age group.**
11. All exhibitors in the Home Economics Division are responsible for the safety of their items. The Fair Association will do their utmost to insure the safety of all items.
12. **ALL PRE-REGISTERED ITEMS BROUGHT TO THE HOME ECONOMIC BUILDING AFTER THE TIME DEADLINE ON MONDAY , Oct. 17<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 P.M. WILL BE PENALIZED 5 POINTS.**
13. **ATTENTION CLOTHING ENTRIES:** Please check entry form, you must state how items are to be judged.
14. All items must be picked up Saturday, October 22, 2011 between 8:30 p.m.-10:00 p.m. **ONLY AUTHORIZED PERSONS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING BETWEEN 8:00-8:30 P.M. TO GATHER ITEMS.**
15. Persons interested in buying items may contact the owner.
16. If there is not a class in the Craft, Textile, Clothing, Food, Art or Photography listed in the rules, enter it anyway and the Superintendent will put it in the right category. Please give a complete description of the item entered.
17. **ITEMS MUST BE ABLE TO HOLD TOGETHER DURING TRANSPORTATION AND JUDGING. IF RECEIVED DAMAGED OR FALLS APART THEY WILL BE JUDGED AS IS.**
18. **Any protest must be lodged immediately with a \$100.00 deposit to the Home Economics Building Superintendent.** The \$100.00 will be forfeited if protest is not upheld. Protest committee will consist of Building Superintendent, Division Superintendents and Fair Board President. Judges decision will be final.
19. All participants in this department must either live in Jim Wells County or attend school in Jim Wells County.
20. **Advisor, Parent or Exhibitor must be present when entries are received on Monday, October 17<sup>th</sup> to insure all entries are in the correct category.**
21. Check all division rules to insure proper information or requirements on entered items are correct.

22. **FOOD NEEDING REFRIGERATION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

2. Entry forms must be accompanied by the Recipe Form attached. **NOT ENCLOSING THE RECIPE FORM WILL CAUSE A 5 POINT DEDUCTION.** Hand written recipes will not be printed in Cookbook. A copy of your recipe must be attached to bottom of your plate/food item. **Make sure your name is not on this copy.**
3. Canned products such as pickles, canned fruits and vegetables should be shown in standard pint or quart jars. (Example: Kerr, Ball, Mason, Etc.) All labels should be 1 ½ inch wide and 3 inches long and placed on the jar opposite the brand name jar. Any item which is canned in other than a standard jar, or is not sealed or is spoiled in any manner will be disqualified. Unless specified on your recipe jar, please underline specifications.

4. Jelly, Jams and Preserves should be shown in the standard pint and half jars.
5. No prepared mixes may be used as the main ingredients except in the creative mixes categories. Classes may contain a prepared mix as only one of the ingredients along with other ingredients.
6. Cakes, Pies and Bread will be whole when entered. After judging, a portion will be cut and put on display. **POINTS WILL BE DEDUCTED IF CAKE, PIE OR BREADS ARE PRE-CUT.** The remainder will be returned to the exhibitor between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. on **October 18, 2011.** If not picked up, the item will be sold.
7. Four (4) pieces of candy, cookies, cupcakes, muffins, or rolls will be required for one exhibit. Baked exhibits and candy should be placed on a snack size paper plate and slipped into a storage zip-lock bag. Breads should be shown in large bags. Items must be packaged to be accepted.
8. Cakes should be put on foil covered cardboard and covered with **CLEAR PLASTIC.** Sheet cakes that are unable to be removed from the pan may be shown on a disposable pan.
9. **ALL BAKED GOOD CONTAINERS MUST BE DISPOSABLE.** Points will be deducted for any items not in a disposable container.
10. Each item entered **WILL NOT** have exhibitors name anywhere on packaging. Points will be deducted if the name is found when packaging is opened by judges and no recipe is attached.
11. Decorated cakes will be judged on looks only.

12. **FOOD NEEDING REFRIGERATION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
13. **Use the sheet provided for your recipe - ready to print. Make sure all ingredients are typed as well as instructions - should it have something missing - we will not print. We will print as received. No hand written recipes will be accepted for Cookbook.**

## Photography Class Descriptions:

### People:

Photos focus from all walks of life, parenting and family, children, babies, models/fashion, sports, and couples.

### Animals-Wildlife:

Category focuses on animals not tamed or domesticated and commonly found in the wild throughout the country and world. Photos can be of wildlife in nature, zoos, and/or petting zoos.

*Examples include: Deer, Snakes, Insects, Rodents, Elephants, Etc.*

### Animals-Domestic:

Photos focusing on the various animals that have been tamed and made fit for a human environment. To be considered domesticated, the animal must have their behavior, life cycle, or physiology systemically altered as a result of being under human control for many generations.

*Examples include: Dog, Sheep, Pig, Goat, Cow, Cat, Chicken, Horse, Camel, Goose, Duck, Hamsters.*

### Marine/Aquatic:

Photos of any living organism in bodies of either fresh or ocean(salt)water.

*Examples include: Fish, Stingrays, Shipwrecks, Whales, Starfish, Etc.*

### Elements of Design:

Images use of graphic elements of design. Photos that showcase line, shape, pattern, form, texture, perspective, etc. Photo can consist of any subject matter. Category is not for graphic illustrations made in commercial programs (i.e. Adobe Illustrator) nor for extreme digital creations.

*Examples include: Perspective, Line, Pattern*

### Nature & Landscape:

The focus of this category includes landscapes, outdoor scenics, nature images, sunsets, urban landscapes, seascapes, cityscapes, and farms. Images focus on the beauty of the outdoors.

*Examples include: Landscapes, Scenics, Outdoors*

### Plant/Flora:

Photos of interesting, unique, and beautiful flowers and flora. Photography can occur outdoors or indoors. Photo subject should be that of a single flower, plant, bush, tree, etc. Large collections of plant/flora should be considered for entry into the Nature & Landscape category.

*Examples include: A rose, an upward shot of a tree, a flower bouquet, etc.*

### Details & Macro:

Getting in close is the name of the game for this category. We welcome pictures of small details that suggest a larger story. This is also the place for macro photographs (although a macro image of a flower might equally go into the Flowers category).

*Examples include: Detail of a knot, a lock, or an abstract close-up - anything as long as it is a tight composition of a detail. Macro examples include flowers, insects, stamps, ice crystals, etc.*

**Digital Darkroom:**

Photos are for digital art-images created or drastically altered in software like Adobe Photoshop. Although digitally manipulated images are also allowed in the other categories, this is a category exclusively showcasing such art. If the digital darkroom work is the main attraction of the photo, or plays a big part, enter it here.

***Examples include: Photoshop composites and creations, images greatly manipulated with a variety of filters, photos with artistic borders, photos stitched into a panoramic.***

**Night Photography:**

Photos taken outdoors between dusk and dawn. Generally these photos are achieved by using artificial light or using a long exposure. This category can include any subject as the focus should be on the skill and technique used to acquire the photograph.

***Examples include: Building/structures, animals, plant/flora, people, etc.***

**Food:**

Category is a still life specialization of photography, aimed at producing attractive photographs of food for use in such items of advertisements, packaging, menus and/or cookbooks.

***Examples include: Thanksgiving dinner, cakes/pies, fruits and place settings, Easter Eggs, sandwiches, ingredients, etc.***

**Dominant Color:**

Photos with a dominant color. The dominant element in the image must be a specific color, such as red, yellow, blue, white, black, green, etc. Black & White photos, duotones, are excluded from this category.

**Catch-All:**

Category for photos that do not fit into one of the other categories. This includes such photos as still-life, motion-blur, zoomed images, and painting with light.
